# Combined IGP-LS Group Proposal

- Proposal: Combine OSPF and IS-IS [from ADs]
- Problem solved:
  - More people exposed to work in both groups
  - Less duplicated overlap work
- Issues:
  - Groups have different audiences and different solutions sometimes
    - May influence choices to be same, when different is better.
  - May be harder to get work done due to convincing "other side"
  - More work for people only interested in 1 protocol.
