- Revision 10 and revision 11 aimed at addressing discusses from Ralph Dorms and Pete Resnick respectively.
- No changes that fundamentally alter the WGLC
- As far as I can tell implementors are operating on the assumption that it's been published.

draft-ietf-v6ops-ivi-icmp-address

- Completed WGLC around 7/11
- 3 subsequent revisions addressing language issues at the request of the area director
- Is currently awaiting IESG review.

draft-ietf-v6ops-ra-guard- implementation

- WGLC in June
- Blocked behind two related documents in 6man
 - draft-ietf-6man-nd-extension-headers
 - draft-ietf-6man-oversized-header-chain

Current Business

draft-ietf-v6ops-464xlat

- WGLC completed.
 - Date on that is open question more than two weeks certainly.
- Two changes made in 08 to reflect discussion in WGLC
 - BIH reference removed
 - IPv6 WAN address sharing removed.
- It is presumed that follow or related work will be spawned
 - BIH for example is dicussed elsewhere already
 - Recently (yesterday) draft-byrne-v6ops-64share-00.txt
