ICN & IoT

- IoT one of the use cases for ICN
- Several claimed benefits
 - Location-independent access to named data/actuators
 - Data-oriented security model
 - Data availability due to caching, in-network forward strategies
 - Ad-Hoc communication features
 - Stack implementation simplification

- NDN-loT
- Cisco
- Others?

Research Questions

- Naming in uncoordinated IoT networks
- IoT interaction semantics in ICN (push, updates)
- Security
 - Security bootstrapping (onboarding, key distribution)
 - Feasibility of ICN PK crypto
 - Other security approaches: ABE
- Semantic interoperability
 - Discovery: how to know what to ask for etc.
 - Semantics and properties of named data and dynamic computation results
- Internet picture
 - Connecting ICN IoT networks to the Internet
 - Role of gateways, translators etc.
 - Possibility of avoiding silo networks
