## Overview of update

- Many editorial and clarification updates based on list feedback as well as review from David Hancock
- Major update was to include a "crn" claim that corresponds to a "reason" or string representing the intent for a call, which has been requested by many.
- There is also a corresponding update to draft-wendt-sipcore-callinfo-rcd-01



## "crn" claim

- The newly added "crn" claim is intended to conveys the caller's intention in contacting the callee.
- callinfo-rcd draft says "this message SHOULD be no longer than ten words; displays that support this specification may be forced to truncate messages that cannot fit onto a screen."
- It also notes that string will be primary format, but keeps open a more extensible format if there is a need.
