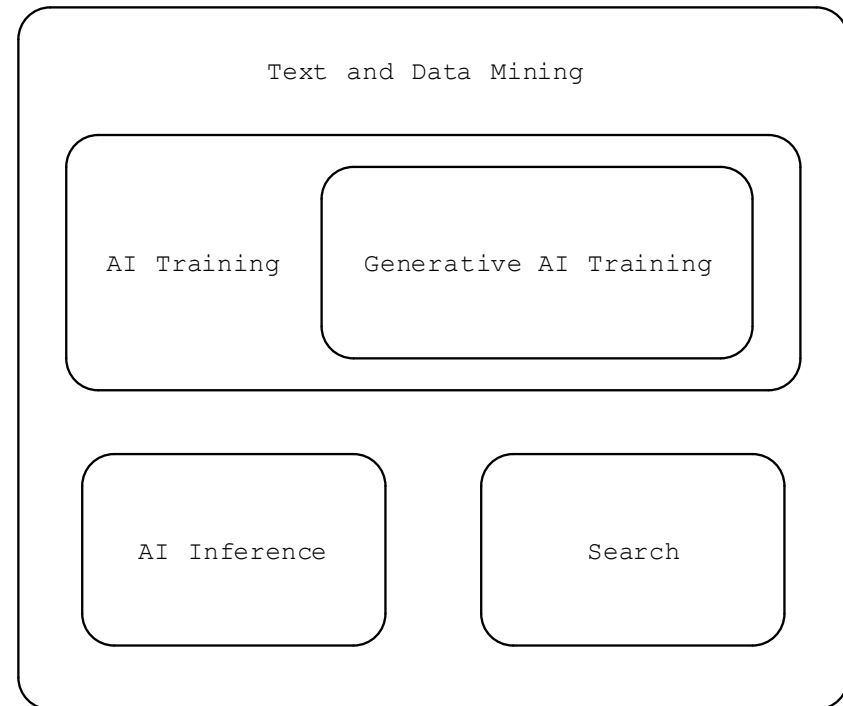

# VOCABULARY: EXEMPLARY SYNTAX

Draft currently uses RFC 9651 dictionary

Key: category of use (as a short string)

Value: “y” or “n”

tdm=n, ai=y, genai=n, search=y, inference=y

Unknown keys and parameters are ignored

tdm=y; day=Tuesday, commercial=n, tou="https://example.com/"

Used in attachment draft; tracked with an open issue ([#7](#))
